1. Introduction:

This Handout gives information about 3 year program: B.Sc. Applied Psychology (Batch-2025)

3. Eligibility Criteria:

- 3.1 The Candidate must have passed 10 + 2 or equivalent examination from recognized board with minimum 50% aggregate marks in any stream (Science / Commerce / Arts)
- Candidates of CBSE / ICSE should mention in online registration / e-admission form (if selected) 10th / 10+2 or equivalent aggregate marks of all subjects for which candidate has taken & appeared for (not best of four, five, six or seven). The candidates should have passed all the subjects appeared for in the applicable examination/s. The aggregate percentage of all subjects for which the candidate has appeared will be taken into consideration for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program at time of admission.
- 3.3 In case the mark sheet issued by the applicable Board / Institution is in percentile/s, the actual aggregate percentage of all the subjects appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration.
- For IB & Cambridge Candidate: Candidates called for admission on the basis of merit list & who do not have final mark sheet will be given "Provisional Admission" based on predicted scores. Fees will be accepted from such candidate but their admission will be confirmed on submission of final mark sheet if found eligible before the commencement of the programme. Mark sheet / Transcripts issued by Board / University / Institute only be considered.
- 3.5 **Diploma awarded** candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered to 10+2 or equivalence examination with 24 grades/credits compulsory and has passed 3 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) plus extended essay and TOK

- 3.6 **DP course** candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered to 10 +2 or equivalence examination with 2 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 2 subjects at Standard Level (SL) OR 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) and 1 subject at Higher Level (HL)
- 3.7 (a) IBCP equivalence for General Strand (Arts, Commerce, Science, Law): CP course candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered 2 DP subjects with at least 1 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and minimum 3 points in each DP subject along with Career related studies with at least 03 subjects offered by IB.
 - (b) IBCP equivalence for Engineering or Medicine Strand: CP course candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered 3 DP subjects (Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology or other similar subjects) with at least 1 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and minimum 03 points in each DP subject along with Career related studies with at least 03 subjects offered by IB.
- 3.8 Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their 10+2 or equivalent examination from overseas board/Universities.
- 3.9 Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 examination from a Board/University where Grade Point Average is given, such candidates must produce in writing from the Board / University concerned, the equivalent percentage for the GPA / CGPA obtained.
- 3.10 Candidates above 25 years of age are not eligible to apply.
- 3.11 Candidate whose final marksheet is not available at the time of admission is required to submit internet copy of result duly attested by Principal of the school/college, failing which candidate will not be admitted.
- 3.12 IB Candidates have to enter 'Predicted Scores' in case final grades/ marks are not declared.
- 3.13 Duplicate registration will not be considered to be eligible for the programme.
- Only single mark sheet with all compulsory subjects taken and passed will be considered, no compartmentalized mark sheet shall be considered.
- 3.15 If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her in the application form is incorrect, his/her admission to the course, even if selected/ admitted, will stand cancelled and fees will be refunded as per refund rule clauses.
- 3.16 Candidate whose final mark sheet is not available at the time of admission are required to submit internet copy / Digi-Locker of result duly attested by Principal of the school / college with official seal, failing which, candidate will not be admitted.

- 3.17 Candidate will not be eligible if any subject is marked as ungraded/fail in the marksheet / grade-sheet.

 For absent / un-graded in any of the additional / non mandatory subject will be consider as eligible provided such candidate is declared as pass by respective board.
- 3.18 Admission to program is considered as "Provisional Admission" till all required and mandatory documents are submitted by the candidate and the same is verified and approved. If it is found that the candidate is not eligible at any stage (even after the course commencement), admission will be cancelled and fees will be refunded as per refund rule clauses even if selected / admitted to the program.
- 3.19 The XII (Qualified) examination should have been conducted before the course commencement date.
- 3.20 Mark sheet / Transcripts issued by Board / University only be considered (School / Institute will not be accepted).
- 3.21 Candidates appearing for their final 10+2 or equivalent examination can also apply provided they obtain the required minimum cut off marks and also produce all the necessary documents, in original, within the given stipulated time.
- 3.22 It is sole responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they possess necessary and requisite qualification for admission to courses at NMIMS University.
