M.Sc. (Applied Psychology) (Batch-2026)

Instruction Sheet

1. Introduction:

The M.Sc. (Applied Psychology) is designed to provide students with a general awareness of the problems of applying psychology, a knowledge of skills required to apply it effectively and a detailed understanding of their chosen focus of application. The concepts of analysis, intervention and evaluation are central to the structure and philosophy of this program. The core modules provide training in research methods and professional issues. The subjects provided in the curriculum further development of these competencies and knowledge while enabling students to consider their application in specified content areas through the study of applied modules and an extended piece of empirical research. This Handout gives information about the 2-year program: M.Sc. (Applied Psychology), Batch-2026.

2. Campus:

- The program will commence only if there are a minimum of 20 eligible candidates admitted after the selection process.
- Admission for M.Sc. (Applied Psychology) program will be offered only through the Entrance Test & Personal Interview conducted by NMIMS.

3. Eligibility Criteria:

It is the candidate's sole responsibility to ensure they meet the eligibility requirements before applying for the course.

1. Candidates should have secured a **minimum 50% or equivalent in the bachelor degree in science**, i.e. B. Sc. from any recognized university in the Science Stream or Engineering or Technology or Medicine or Pharmaceutical Science or in any discipline of Psychology i.e. (B.A. Psychology, B.Sc. Psychology or B. Psy. in Psychology) shall be eligible for the Master of Science course.
2. Candidates should mention in the online registration / e-admission form (if selected) all the subjects which the candidate has taken & appeared for (not best of four, five, six or seven). The candidate shall have passed all the subjects, which he/she has taken & appeared for in the applicable examination/s. The aggregate percentage of all subjects which the candidate has taken & appeared for will be taken into consideration for confirming the eligibility of the candidate for the program at the time of admission.

3. In case the mark sheet issued by the applicable board / University is in percentile/s or Grade point, the actual aggregate percentage of all subjects appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration.
4. Candidate awaiting the results of the final year examination may also apply.
5. Candidates called for admission based on the merit list, who do not have a final marksheet will be given "Provisional Admission". Fees will be accepted from such candidates, but their admission will be confirmed on submission of the final marksheet on or before 30th September'2026. The candidates' admission will be revoked if they fail to present the mandatory documents as specified.
6. Candidates whose final marksheet is not available at the time of admission are required to submit an internet / Digi-locker copy of the result duly attested by the Principal of the college, failing which the candidate will not be admitted to the program.
7. Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their examination from Overseas Universities. Applicable to candidates of distance learning/ correspondence courses/ open school too, who have completed their examination from overseas boards / Universities. If the AIU is not submitted, the candidate will be considered ineligible.
8. Candidates who have cleared their graduation by doing a part-time course or through distance learning, correspondence courses, externally, or open school from a recognized University are eligible to apply & register as per UGC guidelines.
9. Candidates whose final mark sheet of the qualified examination is not available at the time of their provisional admission, is required to submit their final marksheet copy as soon as the result declared. In such a case, if the candidate fails to meet the required eligibility criteria, then his admission will be cancelled, and the fees will be refunded as per NMIMS refund rules (even after course commencement).
10. The Graduation (Qualified)examination should have been conducted before the program commencement date. Candidates who have passed or have appeared for graduation examination from a university where a grade point average is given must produce the equivalent percentage for the GPA/CGPA obtained in writing from the respective university. Marksheet / Transcripts issued by the Board / University only will be considered (School / Institute will not be accepted).
11. It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they possess the necessary and requisite qualifications and eligibility for admission to courses at NMIMS University, as verification of the document is done at the time of admission. If found not eligible during the year, admission will be cancelled, and a refund as per the UGC norms.

4. Online registration & Payment of registration fee:

4.1 Online registration:

- Before filling the online form, please read all the instruction carefully mentioned in instruction sheet & important dates

4.2 Payment of registration fee:

- The online registration fee of Rs 2,500/-
- Registration Fee is non-refundable / Non-transferable.

5. Call Letter & Document upload:

- Candidates who are registered successfully will be called for Entrance Test first. On the basis of information indicated in the Application Form, call letter for Entrance Test will be communicated to the candidate as per important dates.
- Then, only SHORTLISTED candidates will be called for Personal Interview as per the important dates schedule.
- Upload below mentioned list of documents before Entrance Test & Personal Interview scheduled. It is an important and primary requirement to upload the mandatory documents before Entrance Test.

- Candidates are required to download the call letter from their dashboard. No separate call letter will be mailed or posted to the candidates.

6. Selection Process:

Merit list will be based on the performance of the Entrance Test & the Personal interview
Entrance Test (50 Marks, 60 minutes) followed by Personal Interview (50 Marks)

- **For cancellation/withdrawal of admission:** Withdrawal/cancellation means voluntary withdrawal/cancellation by the candidate for any reason. Candidate has to upload the cancellation form duly filled and signed, fees paid receipt copy & cancelled cheque (personal account) to the mentioned link : <https://upload.nmims.edu/admission/cancellation/>
- Please see the important dates and preserve it as a guide. All announcements from the institute will be through its website www.nmims.edu / on the candidate's dashboard and no individual communication will be sent to the candidates. Kindly check the website regularly for any updates.
- If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/ her in the application form is incorrect, his/her application for the admission to the program, even if selected, will stand cancelled and fees will be refunded as per NMIMS refund policy.
- Admission to the program is considered "Provisional Admission" until all required and mandatory documents are submitted by the candidate on or before September 30, 2026, and these are verified and approved. If it is found that the candidate is not eligible at any stage of the program, even after the course has commenced, the candidate will be discontinued from the program, the admission will be canceled, and fees will be refunded in accordance with the UGC refund policy.
